Learning Outcomes:

Students will know the difference between academic and workplace research.

Students will understand the basic research process.

Lesson Plan (10 minutes):

- Academic vs. workplace research

- The research process
 - Student application: tie to past lessons of audience/resume writing
- Secondary research
 - Student application: If I was researching new billing platforms, what kind of secondary research could I conduct?
 Can you use secondary research in a job search? How?
- Primary research
 - Student application: Kinds of primary research I could do if I'm looking at a job with Microsoft.
